

# **Last Week's Speaker**

Mike Borden, executive director of Monterey Bay Teem Challenge, and Pajaro Rescue Mission, began by announcing that Pajaro Valley Chamber of Commerce awarded them "organization of the year."

At the Pajaro Rescue Mission the guests live clean and sober for one year, they learn skills to support themselves, have opportunity to meet Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. They turn food prep into careers. As a culinary school, they learn hospitality while they prepare 19,000 meals per month. Then the get a job at their lodge/restaurant in the mountains of Placer County.

On an annual budget of \$550,000 they run seven centers, provide 77,000 nights of shelter. They have teen beds/shelter, and women's shelter. They are open to receive drug addicts, if they want help. Their success rate is 75% at five years. And they do not take any funding from the government. And 'students' pay nothing for the program.
