Here Comes the Sun

Al Smith was the speaker and he talked about the total solar eclipse, which will occur August 21, 2017. He’s leading an expedition to Madras Oregon with a bunch of folks (maybe even some hoodlums) from Santa Cruz to witness 2 minutes of nighttime right in the middle of the morning. He described how as the eclipse moves across the United States, there will be a 50 mile wide swath of totality [there is one of those words I warned you about] where the sun will be covered completely by the moon. This is known as the Umbra. The reason the moon can completely cover the sun is because even though the sun is 400 times larger than the moon, it’s also 400 times further away from the Earth than the moon. That makes the sun and the moon appear to be the same size.

The featured drink of the total solar eclipse of course is Corona beer. You need to be a real astronomer to get that one. One interesting fact about the eclipse is that when it occurs, birds and other animals perceive the darkening sky as nighttime and they begin to roost or otherwise find their evening dens. Also, The circumstance of day becoming night at the incorrect time awakens our own primordial fear of impending disaster because innately

we know it should not be dark during the day [ponder that one]. Anyway, it was a great program and Al is really enthusiastic.
