Maurice’s Grandson Nolan Rush spoke to us, as he was a participant last year to Italy (Palermo and Syracuse, Sicily). He showed us slides of the friends he made and places he visited. It was wonderful he had a

life changing experience and Rotary provided that opportunity.
