

This is a grass roots community school in the slums of Siem Reap, Cambodia. It provides free education, school meals and community support for over 800 children and their families.

Desalination Project

Fellow Santa Cruz Rotarian and spokesperson for Deep Water Desal, Kim Adamson, gave a presentation about a Monterey Bay Regional Water Project. In the search for new fresh water sources and solutions that can replenish our groundwater basins, Deep Water Desal is exploring the possibility of building a seawater reverse osmosis (SWRO) desalination facility in Moss Landing that would use seawater from the cooler waters of the Monterey Submarine Canyon. They are also proposing to co-locate a 150megawatt data center campus that would be cooled by the seawater prior to desalination. The project is intended to make a new supply of potable water available north to Santa Cruz, east to Salinas and south to the Monterey Peninsula. Kim reported the Environmental Impact Report and the **Environmental Impact Statement** should be done in mid 2017. They hope

to complete the public response and permitting processes to allow construction to start in 2018.

Club BBQ:

This is a great opportunity to spend time and share an experience that is unique to Santa Cruz. October 14 is the club BBQ. This year several of the rides and open area in the lower section of the boardwalk will be closed off for us to enjoy as a club. So invite your friends and family to enjoy the boardwalk, take advantage of a little Rotary hospitality and see your Rotary buddies!!
