# Amazing work in Cambodia

Feeding Dreams, Cambodia is an amazing program that provides life skills to children in Cambodia. It was borne out of a Rotary trip to Laos. Several Rotarians, including our own Past District Governor Russ Hobbs, Past District Governor Joe Hamilton and Scotts Valley Club President Rosanna Herrera, took a side trip to Cambodia. They met a woman named Kerry Huntly who told them about a community located in the slums of Siem Reap in Cambodia. Joe and Rosanna gave us an overview of how a grant was created with the help of

Georgie Hildebrand of the Scotts Valley Club.

What started as a conversation over a couple of beers turned into a comprehensive program that provides education, nourishment and other vital services to over 800 children and the community. These children live in a community wrought with alcoholism, malnourishment and violence, but the school is a place where they can be safe, valued, nourished and have the opportunity to build a future.

This is amazing in and of itself but our other speaker, Arlene Gormley who came to Cambodia by way of Ireland, gave a presentation about the vocational school. The school puts 25 kids at a time through a 1-year program to prepare them to work in the hotel industry in Cambodia. Before this training, the hotels were bringing in workers from Thailand and Vietnam because the locals did not have the skills. Today, after graduating, the students are able to work in 5 star hotels, receive various national certifications for the hospitality industry and provide for their families.

In additional to the education, these students are able to open a bank account (only 3% of the Cambodian population has one), and get insurance (only 1% has insurance). More

importantly, since most were born without birth certificates or any documentation, the school helps them get a government ID. This makes them less susceptible to human trafficking, which many of the students have already fallen victim to previously. For just the cost of tuition (\$1400) this school literally saves lives!!
