

Announcements:

The meeting agenda will be flipped with the Detective report at the end of the meeting.

Annie Asche gave an update on our annual Rotary event “the British Invasion” which will be held on March 11th. If anyone has any silent or live auction items they would like to donate, please contact Annie. She also announced that there is still room for 10 more people to attend the “Super Bowl” party sponsored by Annie and Blaine Brokaw. Tickets are \$100 per person.

She also mentioned that she has \$31,500 so far in event sponsorships but would love some more sponsors. Please contact her about sponsoring.

Detective Report:

Kris Munro was our detective and due to the inauguration of President Trump, her theme was “President Trivia”.

Program:

Dan Haifley, the Executive Direct of O’Neill Sea Odyssey was our speaker. He thanked our Club for all of our support to their program over the past several years.

Dan’s topic for our meeting was the history of the Monterey Bay Sanctuary since we are celebrating the 25th anniversary of the sanctuary.

Designated in 1992, Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary (MBNMS) is a federally protected marine area offshore of California's central coast. Stretching from Marin to Cambria, the sanctuary encompasses a shoreline length of 276 miles and 6,094 square statute miles (4,601 nmi2) of ocean, extending an average distance of 30 miles from shore. At its deepest point, MBNMS reaches 12,713 feet (more than two miles). It is one of our nation's largest marine sanctuaries, larger then Yellowstone National Park. The sanctuary contains extensive kelp forests and one of North America's largest underwater canyons and closest-to-shore deep ocean environments.

Save our Shores began in 1978 and by 1992 they were able to protect ½ of California’s coast from oil development. In 1985, 82% of Santa Cruz voters agreed to: 1) ban onshore facilities and 2) fight drilling off California. 26 Coastal communities followed suit and protected the coast.



In 1988 US Representative Leon Panetta began working on the creation of the Monterey Bay Sanctuary. 4,000 citizens attended public hearings and wrote letters in support of the sanctuary. In 1992 President Bush approved largest boundary and declared a 10 year

moratorium on offshore oil drilling north of San Luis Obispo. And finally in September 1992 the Monterey Bay Marine Sanctuary was established. AWESOME!!!
