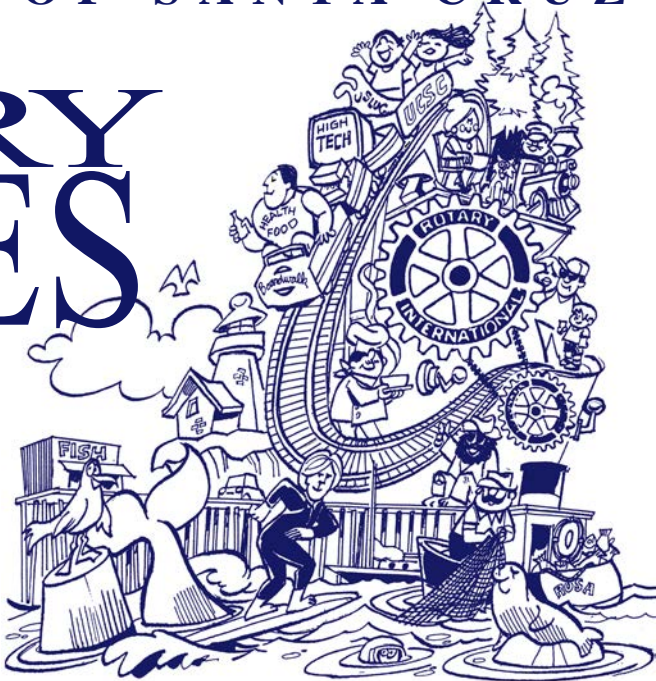

Rotarian Bruce McPherson (Supervisory McPherson) announced that the roads

in Santa Cruz County are now worse than they were in the storms of 1982 and 1989. There is 37 million dollars in road damage and this figure may continue to climb. Federal and State financial relief is on the way (check is in the mail).

Annie Asche reminded everyone about our annual event “The British Invasion” which is on March 11th. She announced that she now has \$40,000 in sponsorships. And, so far we have 140 people who have committed to coming to the event and she hopes to see everyone there.

Program:

Kim Adamson introduced our speaker, Virginia Johnson whose topic for our meeting was Community Choice Energy. Monterey Bay Community Power is a regional project among local government agencies that aims to provide electricity to residents and businesses throughout Monterey, San Benito and Santa Cruz Counties through the new Community Choice Energy (CCE) model. CCE enables

communities to choose clean-source power at a cost equivalent to PG&E, while retaining PG&E’s role in maintaining power lines and providing customer service. The CCE model helps ensure local economic vitality because money from rates paid by local customers stays local. Surplus revenues that would normally flow to PG&E will stay in the community to help fund renewable energy projects, create jobs and stimulate the economy.



Supervisor McPherson has been championing this project for the past 4 years and the Santa Cruz Board of Supervisors will be voting on February 28th at 9:00 am to officially establish the Monterey Bay Community Power. For more information go to www.montereybaycca.org
