

Tom grew up in the Chicago area, thousands of miles from the nearest ocean, mountain or canyon. He became interested in science at an early age, thanks to Dad's encouragement. He received degrees in geology at the University of Chicago and Washington University. While in grad school Tom began to learn "computer programming" - what is now called "software engineering", and worked as a software engineer for commercial instrument companies after graduation. He joined a team at Arizona State University in 1989 to build the "Thermal Emission Spectrometer", which mapped minerals on the surface of Mars from the orbiting Mars Global Surveyor spacecraft. Tom joined the Monterey Bay Aquarium Research Institute in 1995, where he helps develop instruments and autonomous vehicles that explore the chemistry, biology and geology of the ocean.
