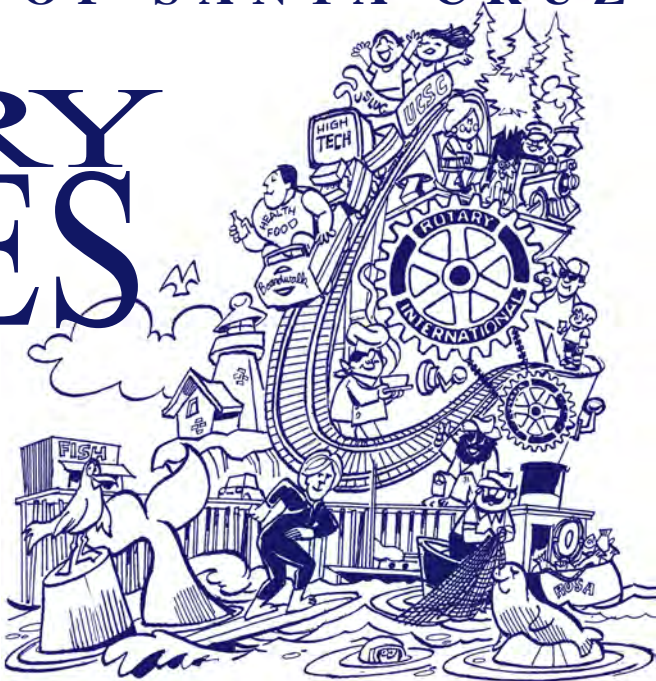

The Rotary District Training Assembly will be held on April 13th in Milpitas. If you want to attend, please contact President Sid.

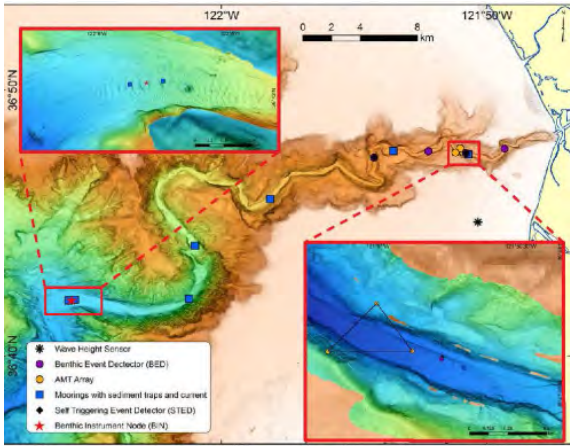
Joe Hamilton, Past District Governor announced that our new District Foundation Chair is Russ Hobbs. This is a 3 year term. Congratulations Russ!

Program:

Our speaker today, Tom O'Reilly joined the Monterey Bay Aquarium Research Institute in 1995 as a software engineer where he helps develop instruments and autonomous vehicles that explore the chemistry, biology and geology of the ocean. Specifically with this project,

they are looking at the Monterey Canyon.



Underwater avalanches and turbidity currents carry huge amounts of sediment, organic material, and pollutants down submarine canyons and into the deep sea. Yet geologists know very little about how sediment moves during these events. Marine geologists from several countries are placing dozens of sophisticated instruments in Monterey Canyon. This international effort, the Coordinated Canyon Experiment (CCE), promises to give scientists a uniquely detailed and comprehensive view of sediment movement within the canyon

The project is being led by MBARI geologist Charlie Paull, in collaboration with researchers from the United States Geological Survey, the Ocean University of China, the National Oceanography Centre in Southampton,

England, and the University of Hull, England.
