Brad introduces a strategic plan to chart the coarse of our future, 'who are we?', 'who do we serve first?'
The answers are not simple, but we need to honor the tradition and respect the work that has been done in the past, but be relevant to younger folks.

More didactic questions, Are we a service organization that attracts members? Or are we a membership

organization that provides service? Sorry I can't provide the answers, but wanted to remind everyone that we do need to continue the thought process.
