Speaker Introduction:

Dr. Martin Fishman is an ophthalmologist in Los Gatos where he has practiced medicine since 1976. He graduated from UC Berkeley, and trained in medicine and ophthalmology at UCSF Medical School, Washington University, and the National Institutes of Health.
