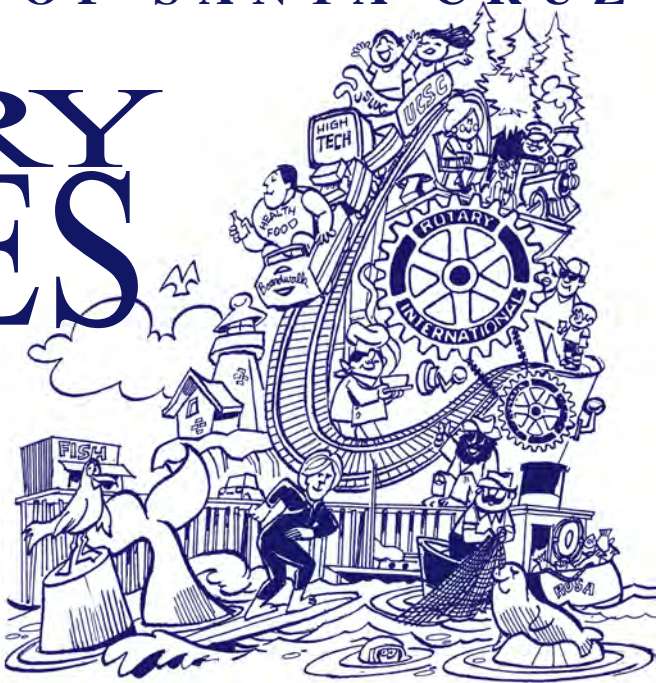

Our speaker, Mike Splain talked to us about the fantastic service the Ventana Wildness Alliance (VWA) performs to help keep our open space wild and healthy for all of the plants, critters and watershed. There are 300 miles of trails maintained with VWA volunteers and one day a group of volunteers hauled out 10,000 pounds of trash. They also run an amazing Youth in Wilderness program. They reached 466 students and provided

2000 hours of education. Some fun facts: there are 350 campsites, 6 major central coast rivers start in the Ventana Wilderness. Since it is a National forest there are only primitive tools allowed (no chain saws) and since it is public land there is no entrance fee. So next time you are planning an activity for the family, take a trip to the forest. It is good for the soul.
