## **Last Week's Program**

A couple announcements followed. John Huffman, treasurer of the Foundation reminded the body that our donations will be matched two-for-one by Bill and Melinda Gates. Our club's goal is \$26.50 from each member.

A change has been made on the board of directors. Jeanette Pagliaro is an incoming Jr. Director.

Our club has given the Coastal Watershed Council \$8500. This organization has reached out to 3452 students, 18 schools, 342 lessons, and 16 teachers. And recognized as a watershed ranger, **Sid Slatter** will preserve and protect our waterways! Hurrah.

Stoney Brook was the detective of the day, and his theme was remembrance of the 73d anniversary of D-day. Some facts we try to remember, 156,000 Allied troops participated from 13 nations. Eisenhower had command of the European theater, with ground forces

commanded by Bernard Montgomery, a Brit. Losses on that day were 15,000 allied, (10,000 American) and 9000 German.

Phil Kramer, the executive director of Homeless Service Center Santa Cruz, was the guest speaker of the day. We all seemed to be tense holding back our questions during his program, and he fielded a few interruptions, pleasantly.

Background homeless stats: 560,000 homeless in USA 59,000 in LA county 60,000 in NY City 7000 in SF, 2000 in SC Co. These estimates come from counts done every two years from communities that accept federal grants. The numbers in Santa Cruz seem high. Do we ask why, or why not?

HSC, with a \$5M budget tries to house them, then provide services and support to get them connected to social services. HSC tries to disrupt the status quo, providing housing for 570 people, 200 at the HSC. They also provide a restorative care

center, at a cost of \$125/day, preventing patients from being put directly back onto the streets from hospital discharge.

HSC goal is to strive for a functional zero homeless rate, with homelessness being non-recurrent, and brief.
