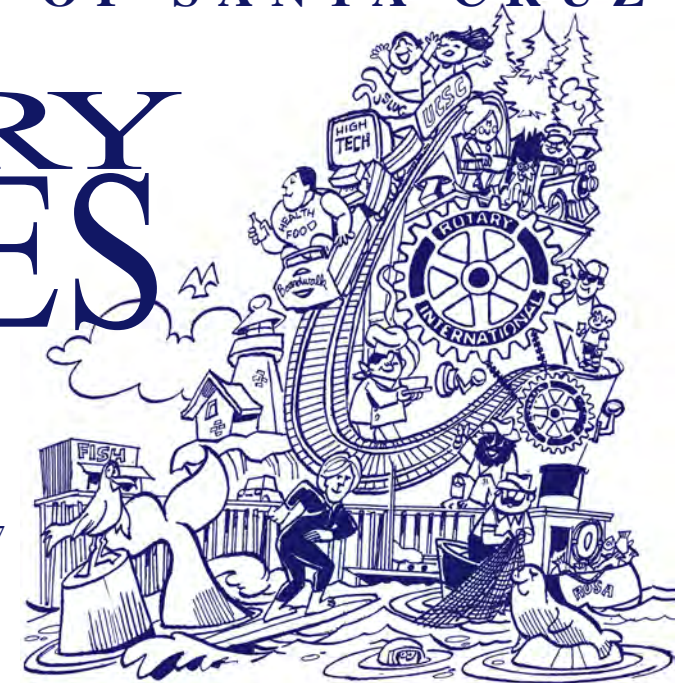

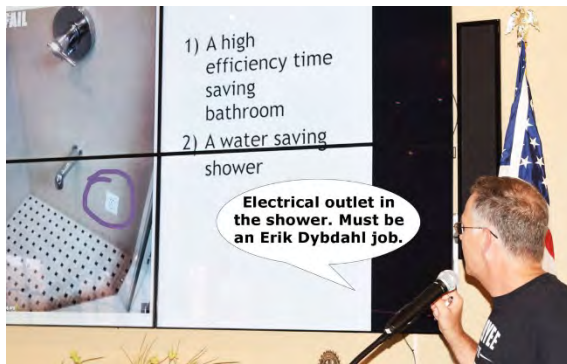

Last Week's Program

State Senator Bill Monning provided some insight into legislation that was recently passed along with legislation in the works.

Senator Monning spoke about the impact and ramifications of SB-1, otherwise known as the gas tax bill. The bill will raise approx. \$52.4 billion over 10 years with increases to the gasoline and diesel excise taxes, the diesel sales tax, and vehicle registration fees. The revenue will be used to maintain and improve transportation infrastructure. The increased taxes and fees are expected to cost Californians \$10/mo.

The Senator discussed SB-623 which would establish the Safe and Affordable Drinking Water Fund to make drinking water solutions available to low-income Californians who lack safe and affordable drinking water. The bill remains with the Committee on Appropriations.
