# Last Week's Program

John Leopold, First District Supervisor, was present and gave an update on plans for District 1. He focused first on development and housing. John mentioned that currently they average 12-15 ADU's per year in the unincorporated area of Santa Cruz. He would like for that number to increase to about 40. Some ways to help increase this number is by reducing costs such as eliminating extra charges for utility hookups that are connected to municipal utilities.

Mr. Leopold also discussed transportation and Measure D. Some of the major roads such as Old San Jose Road have reopened, but there are still over 200 roads in the unincorporated area that still need repairs.

Lastly, he addressed quality of life in Santa Cruz. The major issues are homelessness, drugs and mental health. One of the biggest projects includes the 180/2020 initiative. A stat that John threw out was that there are over 20,000 individuals with drug and/or alcohol issues and about 3,000 are ready for treatment leading to recovery, but the county only has the resources to help 1,200 at a time. They recently received a grant to help an additional 1,000 people.
