Last Week's Program: Santa Cruz County Greenway

Bud Colligan gave a very interesting and persuasive presentation regarding the case for a bike-and-pedestrian-only trail option for the rail corridor currently slated to become a mixed use rail trail with a train and a narrower trail for bike and pedestrian use.

Among the points Mr. Colligan presented for the abandonment of the current plan and the adoption of the new, bike-and-pedestrian-only plan included: increased safety of pedestrians and bicyclists, a wider trail that separates bicyclists from pedestrians, a more aesthetically pleasing rail corridor, a more efficient means of connecting neighborhoods, lower impact on the environment (no clear-cutting trees), lower overall cost of the project, a more feasible alternative to implement, and an option to "bank" the rail corridor for future use by trains, if necessary.
