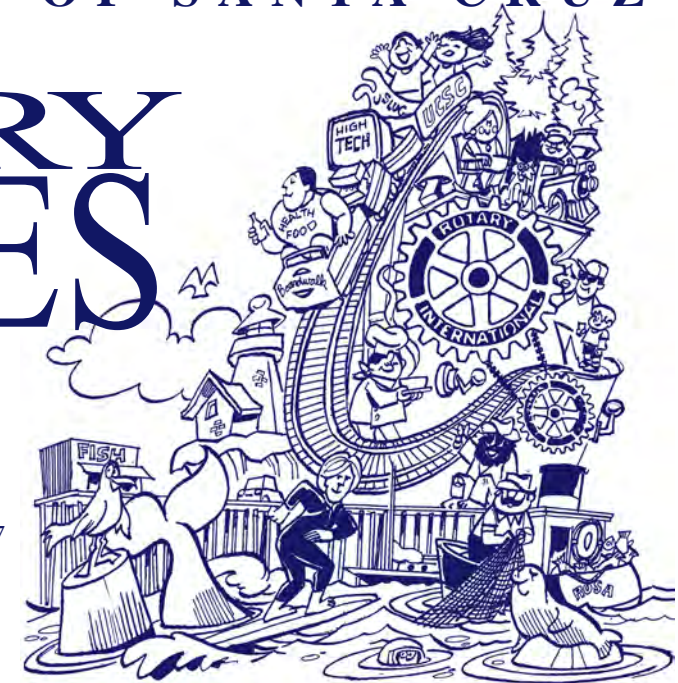

## Last Week's Program: Buoy Labs, Inc.

Hilary Bryant, fellow Rotarian (Sunrise), former Santa Cruz Mayor, and Co-Founder of Buoy Labs, led a very interesting program highlighting Buoy Labs.

After some friendly ribbing of our club, Hilary spoke about what led her from public service to the private sector. Her frustrations with the pace of progress in the public sector and the good fortune of teaming with a brilliant group of engineers led to her co-founding buoy labs, which has the goal of measuring water usage to assist the user in limiting water waste.

The product is a water usage monitoring system that connects to your water line and, through data analytics, can determine where leaks are in your home. With a high level of accuracy, the product alerts you of leaks and overuse via a smart-phone app. This is particularly impressive when you consider the product is a single system without ancillary sensors in other parts of your home or yard.
