## CASA - Court Appointed Special Advocates

Cynthia Druley first thanked Santa Cruz Rotary for sponsoring CASA, including making it the target for the Fund-A-Need Auction at this year's Rotary Roundup.



About 500 children enter foster care in Santa Cruz county every year when removed from homes where they are abused, abandoned or neglected. Court Appointed Special Advocates help these children, working with families in the hope of reuniting them in a corrected situation.



These children need more support than any other children in the community. Foster care

initially looks for extended family members to help out but turns to CASA when that fails. On any given day there are about 350-400 children in the foster system, 160 in the CASA program and 25 are waiting for CASA support. Ages range from newborn to 21 years old.

CASA volunteers are trained and become officers of the court. Their focus on the needs of the children is not easy, but while seeking to change the lives of the children they often find their own lives changed. There are 264 active volunteers who frequently return to take on new cases after the ones they are working on are closed.
