Last Week's Program – Startup Sandbox



Mike Lund educated the club on the latest effort to help commercialize some of the great ideas and intellectual property that is coming out of the University California Santa Cruz.

The idea of the Startup Sandbox is to give students and faculty a wet lab to help them use their expertise in the areas of health, bioscience and technology. The 501(c)(3) will provide these resources to startups to help them get off the ground and validate the commercial value of their products. The facility will include 13,500 square feet of bioscience labs and dry office space.

# <u>Last Week's Program – Startup Sandbox</u> (continued)

Mike did an incredible job of communicating the opportunity of the project to the club, and he also was able to convey the benefits to the business community. This is the first of its kind incubator in for UCSC; however, other Bay Area campuses have had success using a similar model.

Mike went over several startups working in the lab on products such as diagnostic testing, sustainable forms of packaging, and genome sequencing for cancer diagnosis.

The organization has visions in real estate as well. They're working on a facility to rent space to "graduates" of the Startup Sandbox program.

The group will also be launching a venture fund taking on limited partnership investments from investors starting at \$500K in an effort to infuse capital into Sandbox startups.s
