

Last Week's Program – Marc Randolph: Co-Founder & Founding CEO of Netflix

Marc Randolph gave a one-of-a-kind story into the origins of internet giant, Netflix. It all started when he was *fired*. But not the *sad* kind of fired, the Silicon Valley kind of fired where you're asked to stay at work for six months with nothing to do.

Marc used that time, along with the white board in his office and his internet connection, to vet ideas to create a new startup.

He and his colleague, Reed Hastings, would carpool from Santa Cruz to Sunnyvale and bounce ideas off each other. At one point, they considered VHS by mail, but quickly trashed that idea. VHS tapes were too heavy, too delicate, and too bulky to send by mail. Later, the introduction of DVDs made them re-think the idea.

They sent a used CD purchased from Logos to Reed's house using an envelope. When it arrived at Reed's house the next day in good shape, they thought they may have something.

The early days weren't easy. On day one, the servers crashed, and at one point, the company was hemorrhaging money so badly they sought an acquisition by industry leader, Blockbuster, a company they would later put of business with their industry disrupting technology.
