# <u>Last Week's Program – Tom Squeri:</u> President & CEO, Granite Rock Co.

The story of Granite Rock started in 1871 when surveyors discovered a quarry that was ideal for supplying the railroads near San Juan Bautista. A.R. Wilson later founded the corporation in 1900, producing rock, paving roads, constructing buildings.

In 1922, A.R. Wilson split the company into three separate companies, Granite Rock, Central Supply, and Granite Construction. Granite Construction was sold by A.R. Wilson's widow in 1936, and they've been separate companies ever since. The confusion over the two, however, remains.

# <u>Last Week's Program – Tom Squeri:</u> President & CEO, Granite Rock (continued)



In 1989, Granite Rock reinstated its construction division. The company now has three main divisions: Construction, Aggregate Production, and Building Materials.

The company works on many projects throughout Santa Cruz and Monterey Counties, including the Highway 1 widening project and the Twin Lakes Beach project.

In the community, Granite Rock has been a leader in philanthropy. They issued the first check to the entity that eventually became United Way, and they fund local schools.

Tom also talked about Proposition 6, which is a repeal of the new gas tax that's intended to fund roads and infrastructure. Granite Rock is opposed to this repeal for obvious reasons, but he laid out a thoughtful case for a "no" vote, including the accountability it would require of politicians and government officials to spend these new funds on construction.
