July 19 Recap


Our speaker last week was Kate Roberts, President of the Monterey Bay Economic Partnership ("MBEP"). MBEP focuses improving economic health and quality of life in the Monterey, San Benito and Santa Cruz Counties. They have a strong board of directors that consists of prominent business leaders in the Tri-County Area, including some of our Club members such as David Heald and Ed Durkee.

MBEP has four core areas that they devote most of their resources to. Those four areas are 1) Transportation, 2) Housing, 3) Workforce Development, and 4) Building a Tech Ecosystem. Kate mentioned the housing trust they set up that raised \$12.25M in funds to help facilitate affordable housing developments. To date, 4 projects have been funded and 6 are in the pipeline. National Ed Durkee Day!!!


