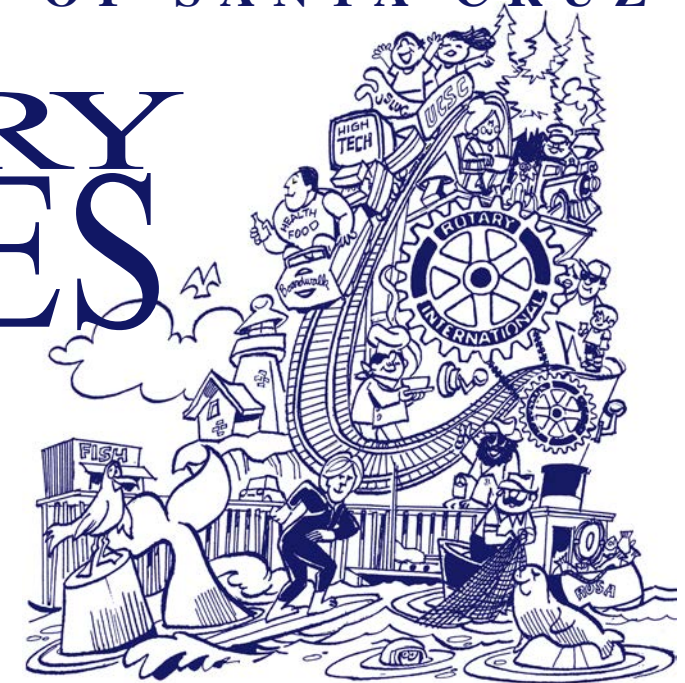

July 26 Recap

The City Manager gave an informative presentation last week on the status of the City of Santa Cruz. The main topics addressed were housing and homelessness. Martin mentioned that 41 affordable units on Water Street were nearing completion and another 205 units on the north side of Laurel between Pacific and Front were recently approved.



On the topic of homelessness, he discussed how major improvements need to be made dealing with mental health and the criminal justice system in order to solve the homeless crisis throughout the state.

One key takeaway was how the City responded to the growth of a home-grown tech company, Looker. The City was flexible in working with Looker to move into the first floor of the building they already occupied. Ordinances had been in place only allowing for retail space on first floors, but Santa Cruz recognized the importance of keeping up with the times of a decline in retail and a rise in high-tech coming to Santa Cruz.
