We were fortunate to hear about the innovation and entrepreneurialism in and around Santa Cruz. For the second week in a row, we were hosts to a new Santa Cruz tech start-up company. Suzanne Wouk shared her latest company, SellHound. SellHound is a company that focuses on aggregating data across many different selling platforms such as eBay, Amazon, Etsy, etc. so that sellers can sell items with little hassle and buyers can find items they want in one location.



Suzanne shared some of the differentiators that her company has to offer for sellers. She mentioned that a seller no longer has to deal with figuring out which sites to post to,

how to market the product, and what to price it at. By providing a few pictures of the product, the AI technology that runs SellHound will propose all these things to the seller and with a few clicks of the button the product is listed. Furthermore, about 10% of postings on major sites result in sales, compared to 30% for SellHound postings.

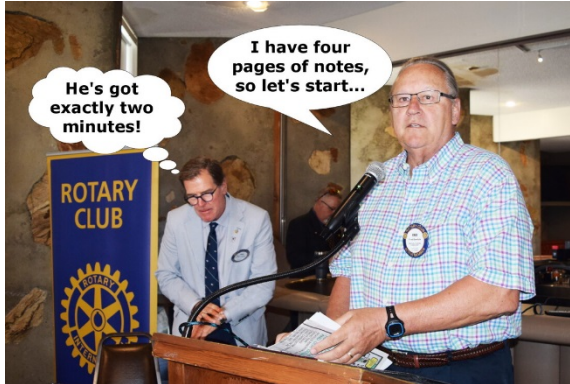
