

# August 23 Recap

Mayor Jack Dilles was the speaker last week and gave an informative overview of Scotts Valley. He spoke about the push, pull of growing Scotts Valley's revenue base while also keeping the small-town feel. The current general revenue streams are sales tax, property tax and transient tax each of which account for 28%, 15% and 14%, respectively, of general fund revenues. The largest expense is public safety at approximately 41% of the budget.

Beyond the financials, Mayor Dilles mentioned some new projects that help punctuate the natural beauty surrounding Scotts Valley. With the help of the Land Trust of Santa Cruz County, Glenwood Preserve hiking and biking trails were completed at the end of 2018. Over three miles of trails were designed and built on the

west side of the Glenwood Preserve. They are currently in the process of repairing and building five miles on the east side of the 170-acre preserve composed of walking trails only.



The last item Jack discussed was the renovation of 1440 Multiversity. This discussion tied several themes that become a vision for the future. The massive renovation undertaken created an increased source of revenue through property taxes and sales tax by an institution that values the natural habitat of Scotts Valley.
