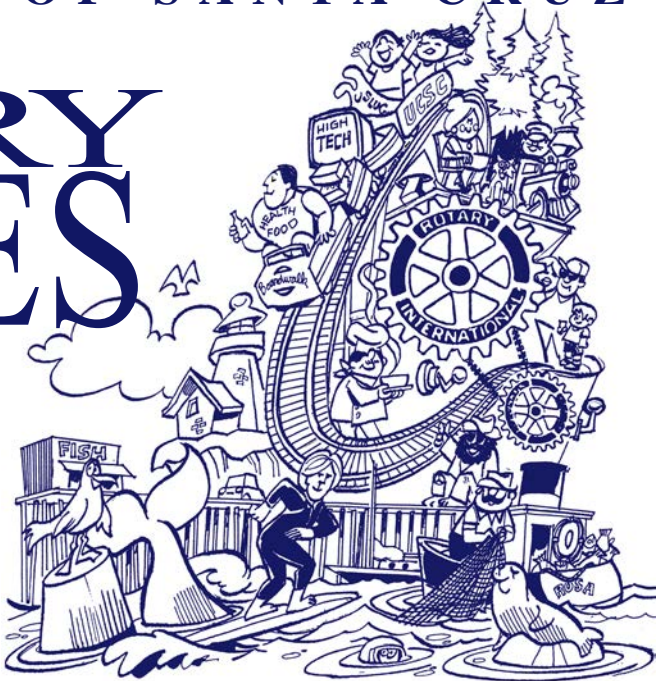

## August 30 Recap

Stew Roth led the PG&E team with an impressive and informative presentation on the Community Wildfire Safety Program. The program consists of three core strategies.



The first strategy is real-time monitoring and intelligence, which is focused on expanding the network of PG&E weather stations and the installation of new high-definition cameras. All the information gathered from these monitoring systems are analyzed at the Wildfire Safety Operations Center. The second strategy is dedicated to new and enhanced safety measures. Vegetation management and accelerated safety inspections are important to the success of this strategy. It also consists of disabling automatic reclosing of circuit breakers, as well as proactively turning off electric power for safety (Public Safety Power Shutdown). The last strategy is system hardening and resiliency. This is composed of installing stronger and more resilient poles, upgrading and replacing electric equipment, and working with communities to develop new resilience zones.
