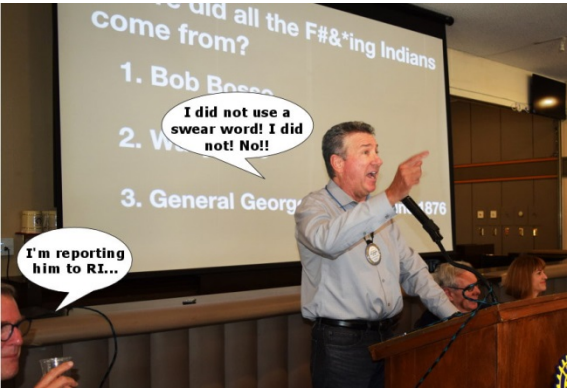
**Quote of the day:** “I couldn’t find anything appropriate for this group” **Bob “pc” Bosso.**
