Caroline Mann from Wings Homeless Advocacy was our presenter.

Wings is a volunteer organization that helps people onto a path of housing and healing. Volunteers live the value of compassion, dignity and respect for those experiencing homelessness.

Wings supports people exiting homelessness at a few key points throughout the journey. They are meeting needs that other service providers are not meeting - they are filling gaps. Like needing a birth certificate replacement for a number of reasons. The Vital Document program is exactly that - vital. SS benefits, birth certificates, ID, etc. Hard process to navigate so Wings volunteers help do just that. Last year they helped process 400+ birth certificates.

Once permanent housing is found, Wings will help furnish that house with basic items like a bed, bedding, and household/hygiene supplies. The push to get housed is good, but making that house a home is imperative and helps people experiencing homelessness feel stabilized and stay housed.

Making a difference in an individuals life is what keeps volunteers going. So when the "homeless problem" seems overwhelming or never ending, Wings volunteers see the difference fist hand, one person/family at a time.
