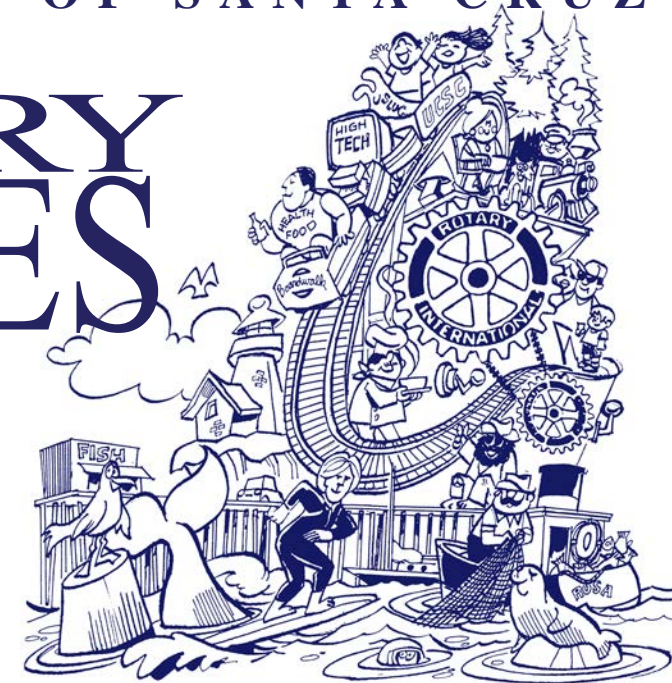

Bob Bosso was the day’s detective and started out with a call for Happy Dollars: Ashley was happy about going to Ireland (in a matter of hours) and finding the perfect onesie for the occasion; Kasey was happy to have sold a lot of houses; Traci shared she is happy and grateful for David Terrazzas and the role he played in getting Common Roots Farm going during his time as Mayor.

Bob then went on to test our knowledge of Santa Cruz County with some trivia. Questions included how many cities, rivers and villages are located in the county. The answers: 4, 2 and 3. How many tributaries connect to the San Lorenzo River (?!). It was a fun one for sure and we’re all grateful Bob provided the report in a multi-choice format.

We then heard about **Common Roots Farm** from guest speaker **Heidi Carten**.

Common Roots farm is an organic farm where people with disabilities join with others to grow healthy goods and build relationships that create community. The farm was started by her and her husband, inspired by her son. There are two main components:

A pocket neighborhood designed without barriers, making all homes visitable. This neighborhood is home to 18 young adults with disabilities. A few homes are also rented to members of the community – students and a young family – because they want those with disabilities to have a chance to socialize with the greater community.

A farm located right in the heart of Santa Cruz which is used as a vehicle to create a number of learning opportunities for those with disabilities. The work on the farm is ongoing and offers a variety of work – from planting seeds, to growing food, to taking care of live animals.
