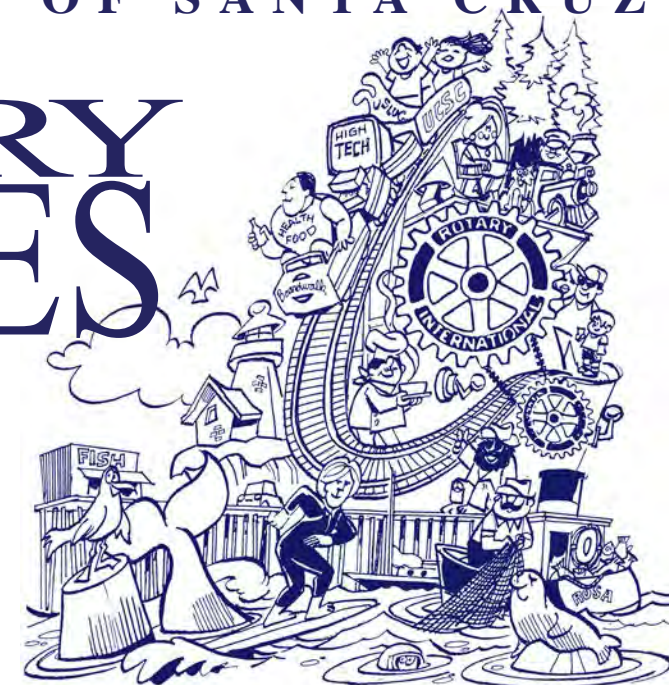

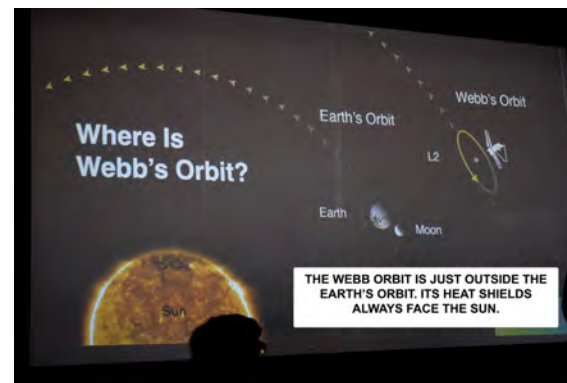
Matt Falconer achieved Blue Badge status. Matt's sponsor in the club is Kasey Hinchman.
