Trying to match Bob Davidson by providing industry related education, **Detective Bosso** started his report calling on Shelli Strahle to teach us about the "Rule Against Perpetuities". OK, just kidding... Bob switched gears and in honor of the upcoming Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, he quizzed the crowd by going from table to table asking questions about MLK and his life to the table appointed speaker.

**Program**: John Ryan, Senior Research Specialist at the Monterey Bay Aquarium Research Institute, was our presenter.

John shared a remarkable "World of Sound" presentation that started us off with the forging call of the Blue whale. His presentation included musical sounds from under the sea, sounds of dolphins, earthquakes, orcas, sea lions and majestic whale calls and songs. We learned about various whale species and the sounds they make and how far some of these sounds travel under the sea.

John shared charts about the blue corridor of whales combining satellite tracking from over 1000 tags, uncovering migration patterns and locations and characteristics of their important habitats. He shared his knowledge about the whale superhighways around the globe.



John explained how ship strikes are one of the leading causes of human induced mortality for several whale populations around the world. He showed us a picture illustrating how the tags are applied to the whales and explained more about the blue whale call detection ranges and habitat preferences. John announced the Whale Fest on April 13-April Whalefest.org
