

conducted annually by the USGA. It is open to professional female golfers and amateur females with a USGA Handicap Index® not exceeding 4.4. The championship was first conducted in 1946The name CordeValle is derived from the Spanish phrase "el corazón del valle," or "heart of the valley." Designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr. and opened in 1999, CordeValle is located in the foothills of the Santa Cruz Mountains, one hour south of San Francisco. The course sits on 270 gently rolling acres and incorporates natural elevation changes, streams and wooded areas into the layout.
