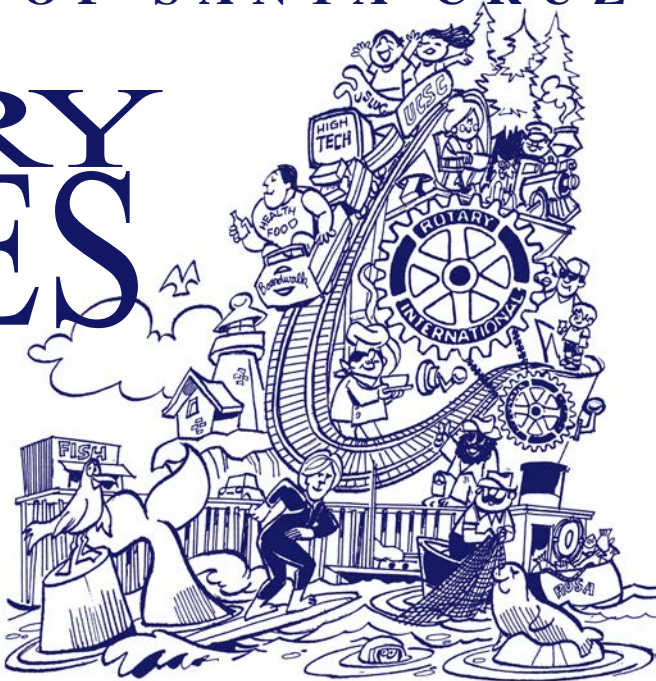

Program: Dan Haifley, Director of the O’Neill Sea Odyssey was our speaker this week. The Sea Odyssey is a science and environment program on the Monterey Bay along with a shore side education center. The program takes 4th – 6th grade students out on the Team O’Neill Catamaran to study navigation, marine science and marine ecology. The field trip is free and the program pays for the students’ bus transportation to and from the program. They also provide free ocean science curriculum for the classrooms. In 2014/15 the program served 207 classes which was 5,500 students. Since 1996 they have served 80,000 students.

Dan Haifley thanked our club, and specifically Larry Wallerstein for the donation we provided last year which allowed them to purchase 3 iPads, cases, and air time while on the catamaran. In addition, they were able to fund the creation of a new software application which allows them to track specific information about each trip and then the students can get this information once they are back in their classrooms using their computers.

Raffle: Our guest, Katherine Donovan won the raffle prize donated by Jeanette Pagliaro which included a bottle of wine and wine glasses.

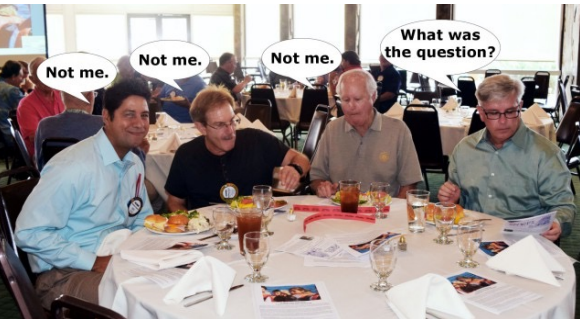
