Tom Parker – He was born in Lincoln Nebraska and moved to Scottsdale Arizona in 1957 with his mother and his brother. He graduated from Stanford University with a degree in Physics. He met his wife while

attending graduate school at UC San Diego. They got married and moved to Pittsburg where Tom worked for Westinghouse in the Research and Development Center. They then moved to Maryland where he attended John Hopkins University and received his Master in Physics. In 1974 the family moved back to California and lived in Los Gatos. His wife’s name is Joy and he has 2 children, a son (Ryan) and daughter (Regan). Once again Tom went back to school and received his Masters in Business from Pepperdine University. The family then moved back East again to New Hampshire for 15 years and finally in 1993 came back to California. He was in the microwave business for many years. In 1994 he bought a house in Santa Cruz near Mitchell’s Cove where he and his wife currently reside. He retired in 2012 but still does some consulting.

Jerry Logan – Born and raised in Santa Cruz. He worked at Johnny’s bike shop all through high school and thoroughly enjoyed the sales aspect of the business. His first adult job was selling cars at Lee Courtright’s dealership. He received his undergraduate degree from Pepperdine University and his Masters in Business from Freeman School of Business. Jerry really likes acquisitions and specifically property acquisitions. In 2005 an event changed his entire life. He fell and crushed 3 vertebrae in his back which required 9 surgeries over a 5 year period. He was a single father at the time and things were extremely difficult. Even though his situation was hard he saw so many others who were in tougher situations than himself. He finally found a specialist who said he could help him and now part of his back is metal but he is

able to walk and even play golf. He told us “It’s not how hard you can get hit but how you get back up.” He has 4 children and 2 grandchildren. He is a real estate agent and does sales training in the Bay Area.
