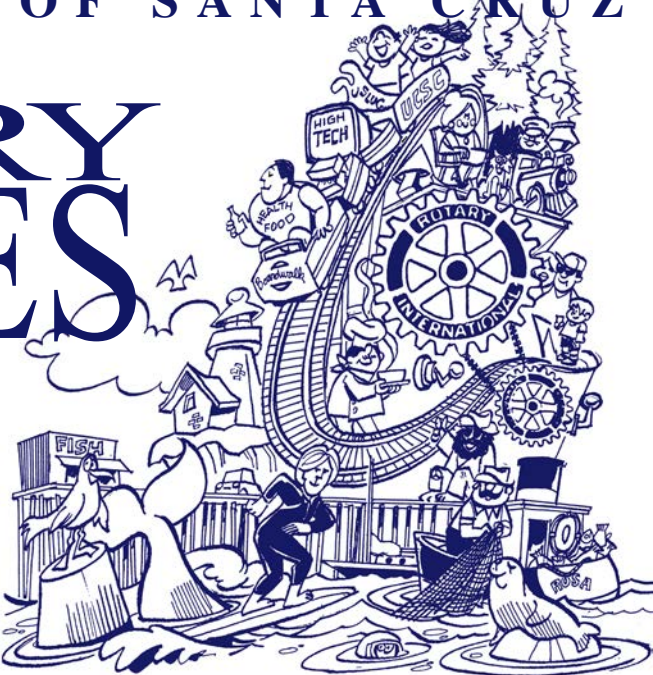

How to Make-up a missed Meeting

You may also gain make-up credit by attending a Rotaract Club, Interact Club or other designated meeting like a district event, club board meeting, special event or committee meeting.

Finally, you may go to the Rotary e-club website and do a make-up online in the comfort of your own home (assuming it's comfortable there).

Making up a Rotary meeting is fun and it keeps your attendance up to standard. Red Badge members are required to make-up one Rotary meeting during their Red Badge term.
