**Program:** Chris Bley's parents convinced him to move to Santa Cruz so they could move here. While living here he became friends with East Germans. These East Germans used

ropes to climb. They worked as rope access workers in their country. This is what got him interested in climbing. His company, InspecTools uses drones to take photos and inspect renewable technologies like wind turbines. The leading edge of the propeller on wind turbines needs to be maintained or they lose their ability to perform at potential. His drones take photos, upload to a cloud, and then send images to the technician's cell phones so they may conduct repairs. His company developed their own drones with proprietary technology that allows the drone to fly an automated flight path around the propellers to inspect them. He used UCSC to help develop the software. He has expanded this technology to inspect solar modules using IR cameras. He says maintenance on these types of technologies is never done which is why drones make a lot of sense.
