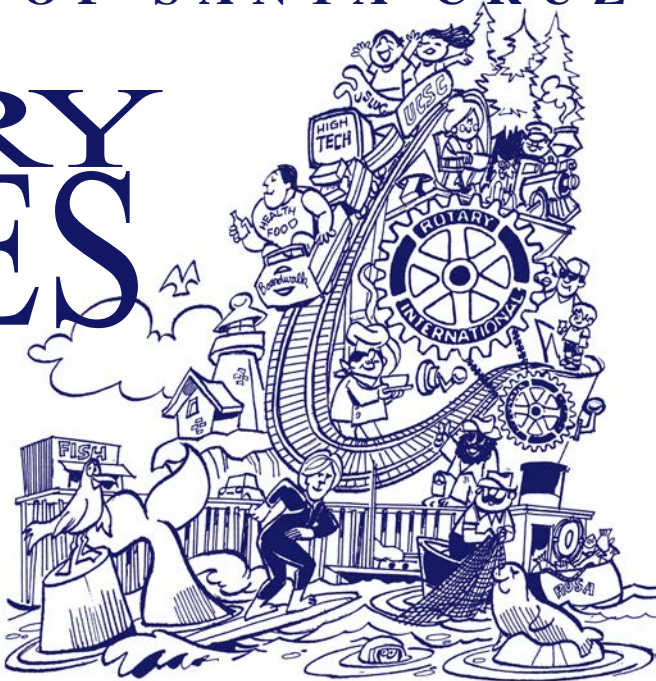

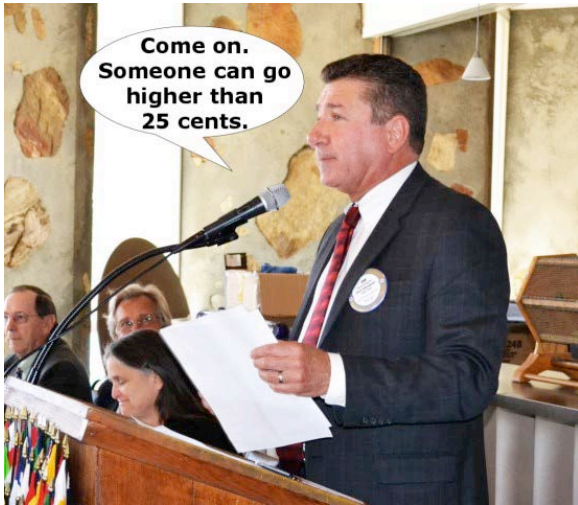

we hope is taken international. Water Warriors is a program that grants a central element to many people. While it is all around us, drinking water is largely unavailable. Many people, including children, are claimed by waterborne diseases. Santa Cruz and other local rotaries have looked into tackling this problem. We have come up with a solution that is ingenious. It is a standalone self-contained system that pumps out 20,000 L of drinking water every day. The systems last upwards of 10 years. Clean water is one of six areas of focus for Rotary international.
