



Frank opened the meeting and Peter Prindle offered words of wisdom and comfort. Cynthia was not at club, so we had a substitute song leader. I can’t remember who it was, so we’ll say it was Bob. Tom Foster gave us a pep talk on Foundation giving which was quite excellent.
Tom also served as Detective and served up a well-crafted limerick in honor of our recently passed member Bud Rice. The limerick was funny and just the right length; yes “This Bud’s For You” The whole club ponied up a few bucks to support the effort.

Our speaker was Dr. Andy Fisher a Professor from UCSC. He talked about ground water recharge and shared his research from our own County. He was an excellent speaker and

his topic was perfectly relevant for the club. I was most interested in how the Central Coast relies on groundwater for 83% of the total supply. That’s by far the highest reliance in the State. Andy gave various solutions to **ameliorate** (Lane that’s for you) the pressures put on water supply. The main solution is conservation. We already do a pretty good job. The State has an annual water deficit. The outlook is pretty dire for lush lawns.

The other useful piece of information he gave was the description of one acre foot volume of water. It’s a pool of water 200 x 200 and 1 foot deep. There you go.
