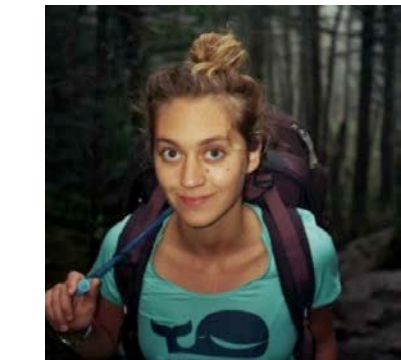

Our speaker was Rob Irion from UCSC. He is a science communication specialist and he runs a program for scientists with advanced degrees who want to become science journalists. The most interesting bit of information I gleaned from Rob’s address was the nature of elements and how they’re formed. He told us that the elements found in our solar system may be different from elements found in other parts of space. In other words the combinations of various protons and electrons are based on the environment in which they’re made. Our solar system was

made from a specific star or set of stars and other solar systems were made from other stars. Elements are not universal; they vary from system to system.
