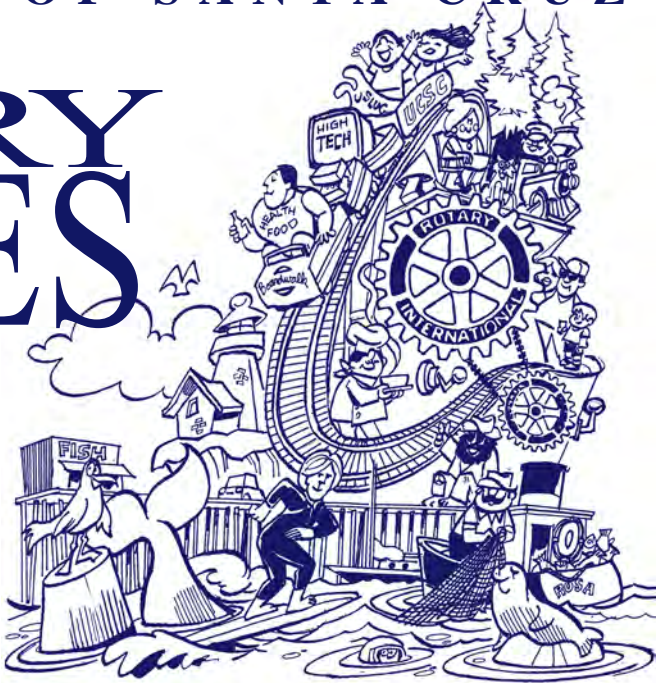

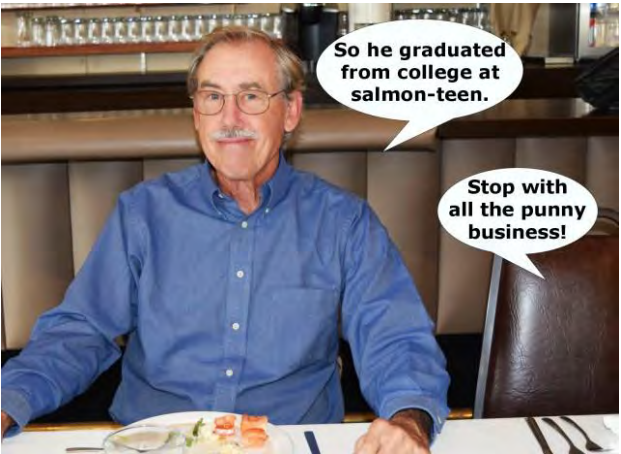

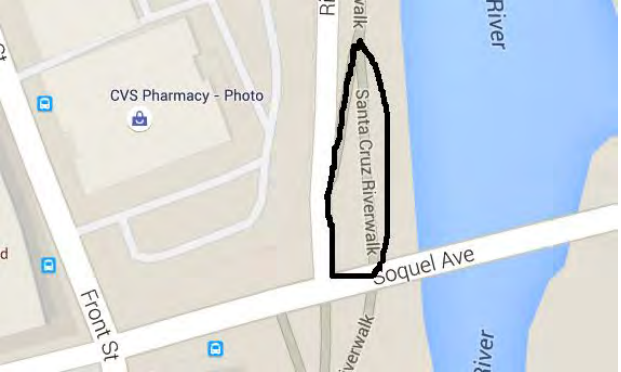
Club Board of Directors Meeting
