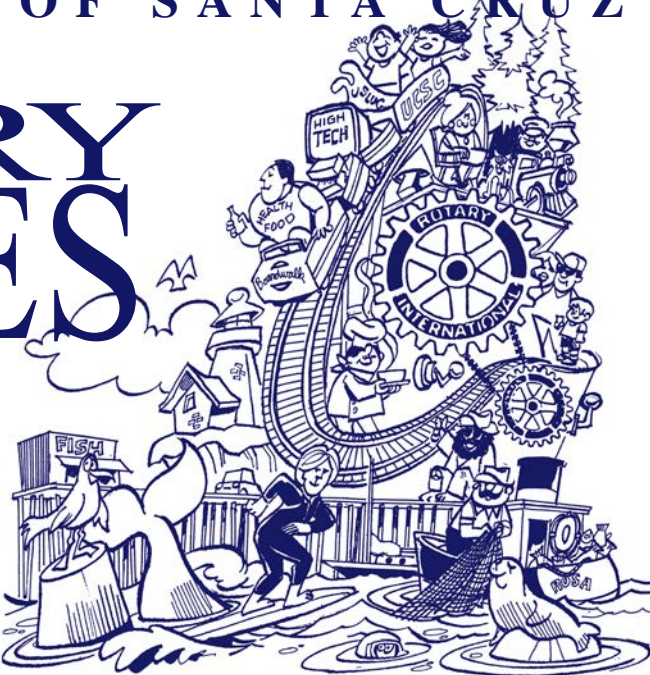

**Special Guest:**

President **Frank Minuti** introduced Past District Governor Roger Hassler, who accompanied our speaker and current District Governor Angie Hassler. Roger and **Frank** inspected the supply of underwear contributed by our members at Roger's request and posed for pictures. Roger explained that the underwear drive was conceived a number of years ago by a student at Pioneer High School in San Jose and he merely adopted it as this year's Governor's spouse program. The underwear is destined for occupants of homeless shelters, and was left with us to make the distribution through local agencies.

**Other Business:**

After DG Angie awarded **Tom Parker** his blue badge and new member **Peter Dean** his red badge, **Frank** proceeded to invite members to join him in completing his circuit of all the Area 7 clubs, which was to take him to Scotts Valley last Monday. He reported that he attended the Sunrise Club earlier that week with a few Santa Cruz members.

**John Huffman** thanked the members for their pledges to the Rotary Foundation, specifically citing 25 Double Sustainers including **Tom Foster** (club chair). Four more members came forward during the presentation to add their contributions. **Fred Gawlick** was recognized as a Super Sustainer, and **Russ Hobbs** and **Bob Rudolph** as Paul Harris Fellows.

**Detective Report:**

Detective **Carol Lezin** observed that there was no time left to extract fines from the members,

contributed 100 "happy dollars" to the treasury in lieu thereof, and sat down.

**The Program:**

Assistant District Governor John Winston of the Sunrise Club introduced District 5170 Governor Angie Hassler.

Gov. Angie told us that, prior to her Rotary career, she worked in the travel industry and as a human resources person. Now, time not spent on Rotary business is devoted to working in schools and her church and in travel. Obviously a baseball fan, she said she has visited almost all the major league parks.

She was quick to point out the importance of Santa Cruz Rotary in the district and recognized several of our members for their service: PDG **Russ Hobbs, Sam Bishop, Tom Foster, Marv Jensen, Ian Mackenzie, Gary Reece** and **Wally Dale**.

The focus of her talk was the importance of maintaining the vitality of the clubs in the district not only by attracting community leaders as new members, but and by retaining our existing members. To do this, she said, we must support those with problems, follow up on those who have left us, and involve family members and survivors. She emphasized that we must make a place for every member of the club and value his or her contributions to the club.

Gov. Angie urged us to imagine each Rotarian growing by changing lives through community and international programs. She singled out Santa Cruz Rotarian **Keith Mckenzie** for his exemplary leadership in visual health projects in Guatemala and challenged us to reach out through hospitality, scholarships, the fight against polio, GSE teams, speech contests and sponsorships like the Seymour Center and the Monterey Bay Sanctuary classrooms. And she called attention to young people growing up

under our noses in scouting, Rotaract, Rotacare, Interact and Camp RYLA.

Gov. Angie left us with a promise and question: the promise is that the lives we change are ours. And the question is, have you told your story?

As a postscript, she displayed the 2014-2014 District Foundation lapel pin, which she described as a carbon atom symbolizing the source of all life and featuring six electrons for the six areas of service.

In answer to a question by **Larry Wallerstein** about what is being done to engage new members, she responded, "You've got the formula." family involvement.
