The speaker was Monica Martinez from Encompass Community Services. She is the Executive Director there and gave us an overview of the services they provide. Monica is an excellent speaker and brought a lot of energy to her presentation. She spoke with conviction and great command of the subject matter. Encompass controls 350 permanent dwelling units in the county and they provide services for adults and children to help keep them out of homelessness. Monica had some chilling statistics about the systems of support for children. For instance children raised in Foster Care have a 50% chance of being homeless as adults. A person's adult life success can be directly linked to the care and support they receive between the ages of 1 and 3.

The problems of homelessness are recognized at Encompass; they know many of the causes and have solutions to help. She encouraged us to engage with them.
