# Meeting:

We had two visiting Rotarians at our meeting this week: Jeff Kirk and Jim Booth both from the Santa Cruz Sunrise Club. And we had one guest, Jamie Ganly who was a guest of Blaine Brokaw. Erik Dybdahl donated the raffle prize won by our guest, Jamie Ganly. The prize was a bottle of wine and a gift certificate to the Silver Spur Restaurant.

# Program:

Deputy Chief Steve Clark from the Santa Cruz Police Department was our speaker this week. Steve has been with the Police Department for 29 years and in addition to his role as Deputy Chief he is also the department's media spokesperson. He spoke about how he goes about "controlling the message" that is put in the media. He uses what he called a "message hub" that resembled a bicycle wheel. There are 4 spokes: 1) wildcard, 2) facts of the case, 3) proactive action, and 4) public concern/danger. He writes a statement relating to each one of the 4 critical areas that all ties back to the center of the spoke which is the "central message".

Deputy Chief Clark also spoke about how social media has changed the way information is provided to the public. With Twitter, Facebook, newspapers, TV, etc. information can be instantaneous. He spoke about the blog that the police department has: santacruzpolice.blogspot.com and their Facebook page: facebook.com/santacruzpolice

The public can also receive Nixle alerts and there is a smart phone app available. The Santa Cruz Police Department was the first police department in the nation to have a smart phone app. They received an award for this undertaking from the League of Cities.

During Chief Deputy Steve Clark's presentation, there were several Rotarians observed using their smart phones. Lucky for them Steve didn't see it or I'm sure a citation would have been given.
