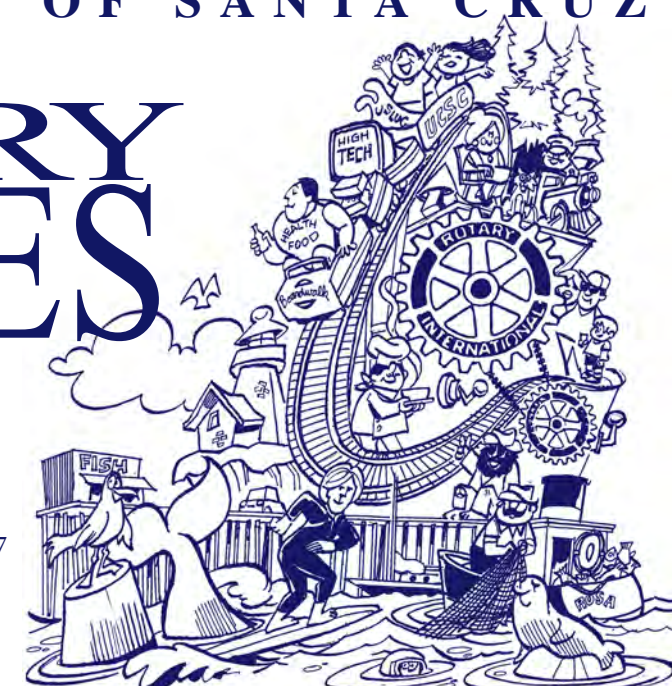

## Last Week's Highlights

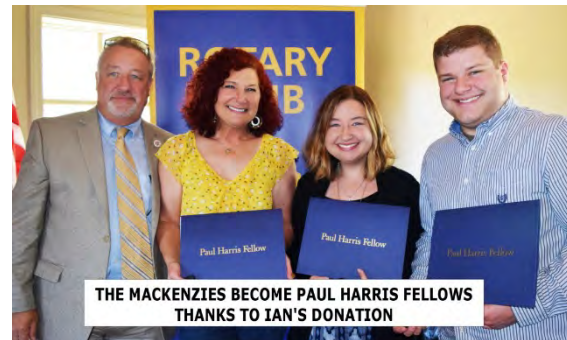
*Invocation:* Masi Bayless gave a heartfelt message which drew a few Amens! from the crowd.

Past President Sid Slatter and President Elect Wes Walker provided a great presentation on the Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk's recent improvement project.

The improvement project focused on creating a new main entrance near Neptune's Kingdom. The new entrance includes an

entrance plaza, 16 state-of-the-art ticket windows, 2 new rides and 2 updated attractions.

Slatter Construction broke ground on September 10, 2016. Despite some major setbacks including soil testing and the wettest winter in the last century, they were able to complete the project on schedule for the Memorial Day weekend.

Some fun facts from the project include:

- 324 tons of reinforced steel
- 2,400 cubic yards of concrete (i.e. 350 cement trucks)
- \$14 million project
