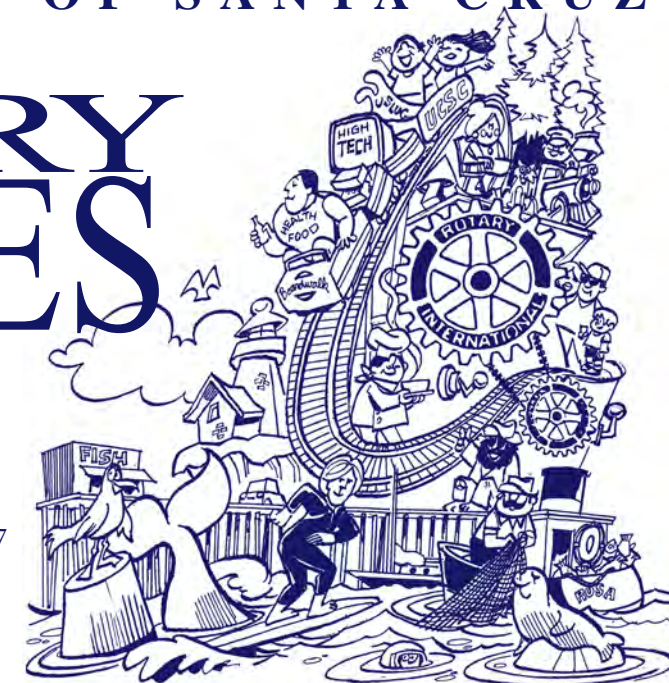

Last Week's Program

District Governor Orrin Mahoney stopped by and gave an informative program about how Rotary Districts are most impactful.

The main areas where the District adds value are: Interact, RYLA, Youth Exchange, Speech Contest, Youth Protection and the Rotary Foundation. The District

can provide the infrastructure for local clubs to join together to extend their reach.

For example, the Interact Club consists of 20,372 clubs with 468,556 Interactors in 159 countries*. Regarding the Rotary Foundation, the funds contributed have helped to immunize more than 2.5 billion children in 122 countries*. None of this would have been possible with clubs acting alone.

He wrapped up his presentation by announcing a save the date for the next District Conference to be held on May 2, 2018. The venue is TBD, but the first choice is the new Apple Campus in Cupertino.
