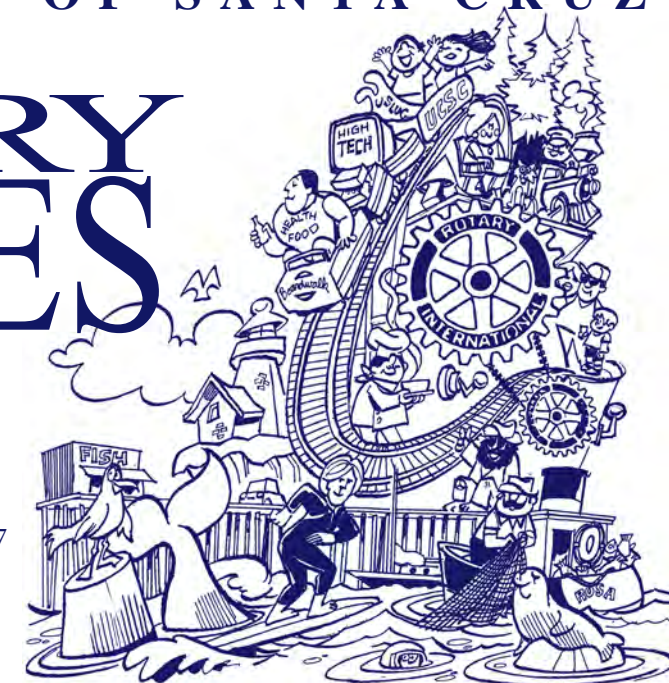

Last Week’s Program

Writer and historian Traci Bliss shared the accomplishments of visionary women of Seabright as presented in her new book titled “Santa Cruz’s Seabright.” Three members of our club received a special shout out for making the book possible; they include Charles Canfield, Jane McKenzie and Rod Atchison.

Some of the women discussed were Lulu Hall Green and her influence on creating a camp in what is now Capitola, Susan Tyrrell and Elizabeth Forbes for their founding of a private library which later became the Seabright Public Library, Margaret Halliday for her role at the Scholl-Mar Castle, and Marion Hollins for the creation of Pasatiempo.

A few historical events and landmarks were also shared by Traci. In 1905, Seabright and the East Side were annexed to Santa Cruz. The population went from 7,000 to 10,000 overnight. Soon after, a permanent footbridge over the San Lorenzo River was built on the Southern Pacific Railroad trestle. The very next year the Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk opened.
