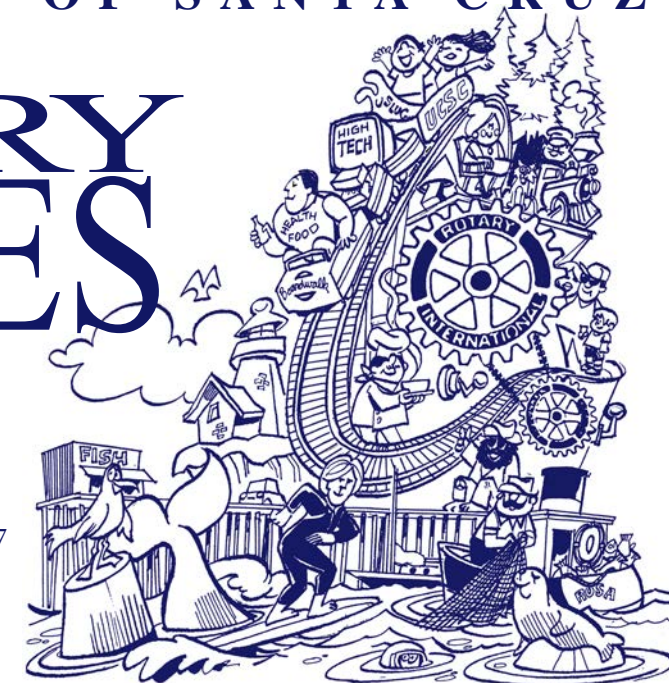

Last Week's Program: Lisa St. John of Bay Area Hyperbarics

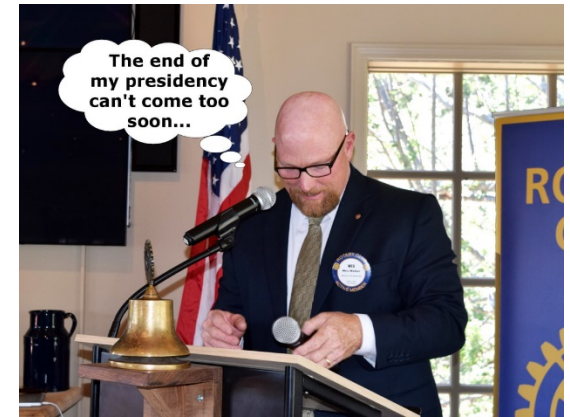


Who knew hyperbaric chambers had so much utility? From the bends to post-radiation treatment and even... ED!?!? Who saw that coming? I didn't...
