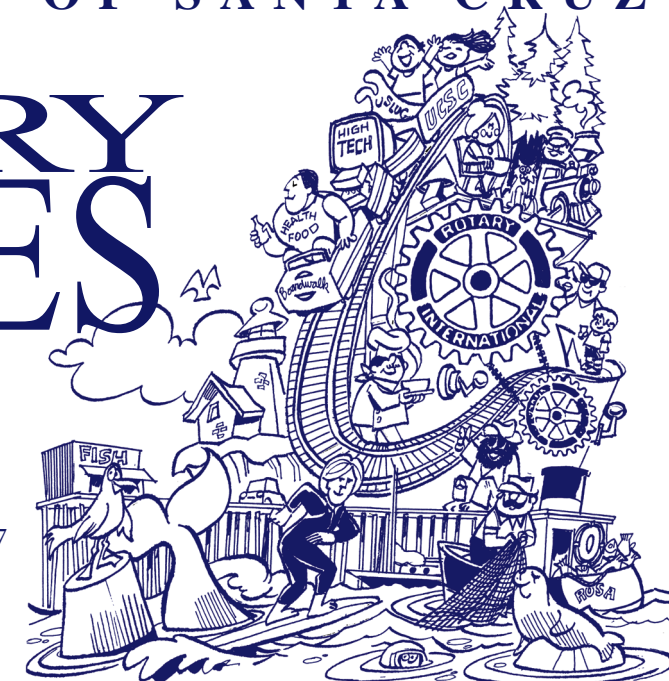

Last Week's Program – Owen Lawlor – DTSC Mixed Use Developments

Last week, Owen Lawlor took us through two, downtown proposed developments and held an extensive question and answer session.

One development is planned to take place at Front, Laurel and Pacific at the site where Taco Bell is currently situated near one end of Pacific Garden Mall. The proposed development will be 6 stories consisting of market-rate rental properties and 1st floor retail.

Last Week's Program – Owen Lawlor – DTSC Mixed Use Developments (continued)

Many factors will come into play that determine whether the project is built, including the outcome of Proposition 10 - California voters' decision whether or not to repeal the Costa-Hawkins Act. Costa-Hawkins protects new developments from rent control imposed by local governments.

Another proposed project would be built at the River levee at Front and Cathcart Street. The Front and Cathcart street development will include access to the levee as well as the subsidized housing required to get both projects off the ground.

Construction is planned for mid-to-late 2019 and will take 24 months to complete.

Together, these projects would add 350 units of much-needed housing but would likely exacerbate parking woes in Downtown Santa Cruz.
