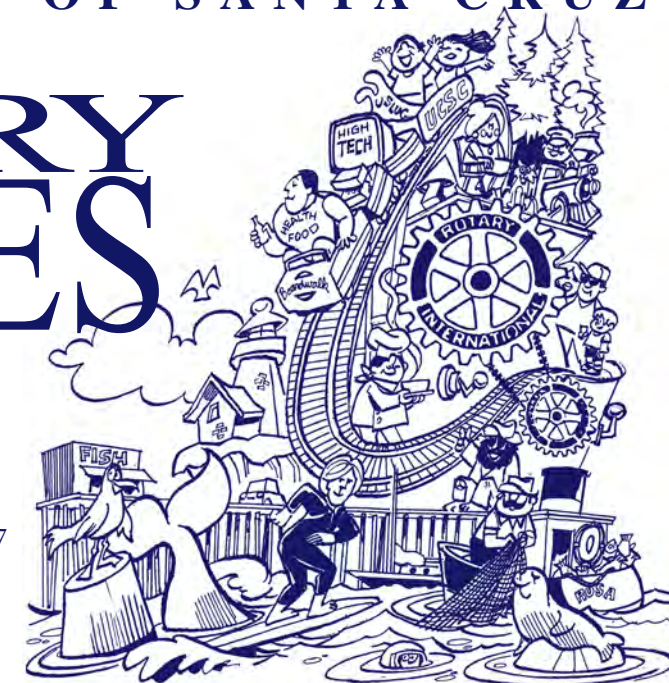

on indigenous people and Christopher Columbus.

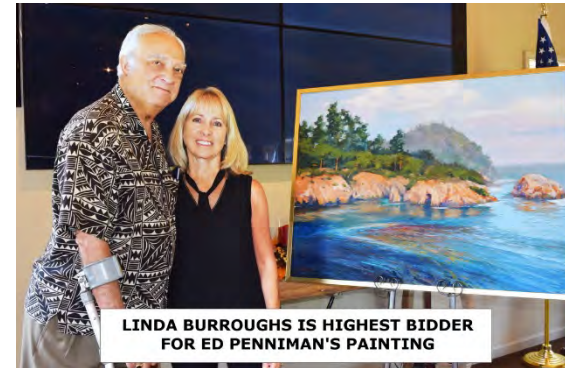
*Raffle Winner:* George Gallucci won the door prize. Apparently, Mike Allard also won because he kept asking what "they" had won.
