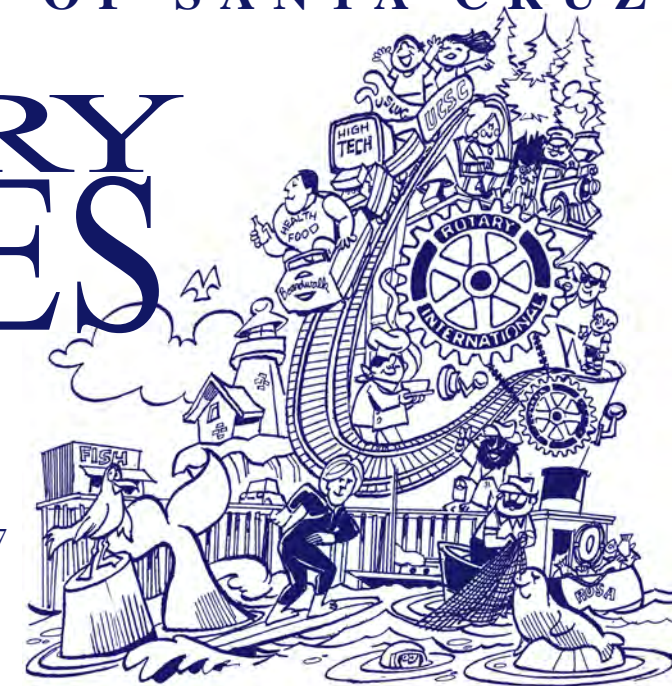

Last Week's Program: Carlo Facchino

The presentation put on last week was a great one. Carlo was in attendance and

shared his historic journey in, around and across the Arctic.

This wasn't his first open ocean row. Carlo participated in a 39-day row from Monterey to Hawaii as part of the Great Pacific Race. However, this journey was drastically different. The adventure began on July 20, 2017 off the northern coast of Norway, where the crew headed to the Arctic ice shelf to achieve a world record for making it as far north as they did as a rowing crew. This was one of 11 world records they achieved.



After achieving this world record, they turned south and headed towards Iceland. They never reached their ultimate goal of Iceland, but luckily, they were able to take refuge on the island of Jan Mayen. The trip was officially over on August 19, 2017.
